

ADDAPAVE TP POROUS PAVING SYSTEM CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDE

Every effort has been made to ensure your Addapave TP surface is of the highest quality. However, it will look better and last longer if a few simple maintenance procedures are adopted.

Routine Maintenance

The Addapave TP surface should be regularly swept clean, removing leaves and detritus material in order to prevent moss growth or possible tanning staining. If the surface has been contaminated with chewing gum it is best removed by freezing and chipping off as necessary. Annual checks should be to check for possible damage to the tree trunk, if the growth of the tree is affected by the Addapave TP installation the Addapave TP finish should be cut back as required.

Normal/Abnormal Use

The Addapave TP surface has been designed for normal pedestrian usage only, therefore protection should be provided wherever possible against abnormal usage.

Abnormal usage applies to heavy objects such as cars, trucks, maintenance vehicles, or any heavy equipment. These should not be driven across the surface, the Addapave TP must be protected in this instance to avoid any impact damage, staining etc.

General Cleaning

General cleaning of the surface can be carried out by cold pressure washing up to a maximum 2200 PSI rating to remove dirt and grime. The water should be applied using a fan type nozzle which should be kept 7-8 inches above the installed Addapave TP. Care should be taken however to prevent damage to the surface with excessive water pressure. Oil stains should be removed as soon as possible, use a mild detergent as required to prevent possible staining.

Damage Repair

Damaged surfaces should be repaired as soon as possible. Please contact the contractor who installed the surface.
